**Промежуточная (итоговая) аттестация по английскому языку за курс 11 класса**

**Тест**

Содержание и структура работы для промежуточной аттестации по английскому языку разработаны на основе следующих УМК: О.В. Афанасьева, Дж. Дули, И.В. Михеева, Б. Оби, В. Эванс, Английский в фокусе, 11 класс, М.: Express Publishing: Просвещение, 2009.

**Цель:** Промежуточная аттестация по английскому языку ставит своей целью определение уровня усвоения учащимися основных знаний и умений к концу обучения 11 класса.

**Условия и порядок выполнения работы (время):**

40 минут (раздел «Чтение» 15 минут; раздел «Лексика и грамматика» - 25 минут).

**Структура и содержание работы**

Работа состоит из двух разделов:

Раздел I «Лексика и Грамматика» содержит 5 заданий (34 балла).

Раздел II «Чтение» (3 балла) содержит одно задание.

**Система оценки выполнения отдельных заданий и работы в целом.**

34 (91%) – 37 (100%) баллов – «отлично»

26 (70%) – 33 (90%) баллов – «хорошо»

19 (50%) – 25 (69 %) баллов – «удовлетворительно»

18 (49%) – 0 баллов – «неудовлетворительно»
